

PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS #101

NOTE - It is recommended that remotes be programmed with the use of a diagnostic tool, however if there are two working keys present this alternate procedure will sometimes add new remotes.

- 1. Insert the first working key into the ignition and turn to the ON position. DO NOT START THE VEHICLE.
- 2. Exit the vehicle and close the Driver door.
- 3. Mechanically LOCK the driver door using the second key.
- 4. Within 5 seconds of the previous step press UNLOCK (on the remote you wish to program) the number of times that corresponds with the memory position listed below.

Memory #1 - Press 1 time

Memory #2 - Press 2 times

Memory #3 - Press 3 times

Memory #4 - Press 4 times

- 5. Wait 5 more seconds and Press the UNLOCK button one more time.
- 6. Open the Driver door and turn the ignition OFF then press LOCK and UNLOCK together on the remote.
- 7. Test the remote for function.
- NOTE If programming more than one remote you must complete the entire procedure for each one you are programming. Each will need to go into a seperate memory slot.
