

PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS #103

NOTE - It is recommended that a diagnostic tool be used for programming as this procedure only programs the remote portion and does NOT program the key if the vehicle is equipped with a transponder. To complete remote programming using the procedure below you MUST have 2 working keys.

- 1. Insert the first working key into the ignition and turn to the ON position. DO NOT START THE VEHICLE.
- 2. Exit the vehicle and close the Driver door, make sure all other doors and trunk are closed.
- 3. With the key to be programmed LOCK the Drivers door.
- 4. Press ANY button on the new remote and release, pause for 2 seconds, press the same button again and release.
- 5. A tone from the horn confirms the remote has been accepted.
- 7. Unlock the drivers door, remove the key from the ignition and re-lock all doors with a key before testing the remote.
